

Joint Press Release For Immediate Release. Monday 21st December 2020.

The Truro partnership (Truro City Council, Truro Business Improvement District and Visit Truro), along with Cornwall Council put temporary road closures in place to enable people to social distance in response to COVID when Truro first reopened in June after lockdown one. Since then the Truro working group have met on a weekly basis to review the situation and adapt and change where necessary.

During the Christmas & New Year holiday the road closures will remain in place up to and including Sunday 27th December from 11am until 4pm. From Monday 28th December the closures will be from 11am – 3pm, 7 days a week.

The Truro partnership will continue to monitor the situation throughout Christmas and New Year holidays and will meet again on Monday 4th January 2021 to review the 'Space to Shop' road closures going forward.
